

# **LAKE EYRE IN A DAY**

## **From Brisbane – Saturday 15 October 2016**

Fully inclusive day trip from Brisbane including in-flight breakfast, morning & afternoon tea, lunch, light dinner, commentary by Graham Reid who has extensive knowledge of south west Queensland having spent many years operating small group tours to Birdsville, Innamincka and around the Corner Country. One of his great passions is the western river systems. Visit the iconic Birdsville Hotel. This trip is so much more than just about seeing amazing Lake Eyre – it's the journey & hearing how the water reaches the lake.

Travel in window seat of a Fairchild Metro 23 with a maximum 17 passengers, departing from the General Aviation Terminal, Brisbane Airport (via Dryandra Road).

Cost - \$2250.00 per person

6.45am Check-in with Corporate Air at the General Aviation Terminal, Brisbane Airport (via Dryandra Road) to board your flight for an unforgettable day.

7.30am Depart Brisbane and fly over the Darling Downs agricultural farmlands and into mulga country, near Charleville. Travel west over the Warrego, Paroo & Bulloo Rivers, Cooper Creek and the Diamantina River before arriving in Birdsville.

Along the way, Graham will provide comprehensive commentary about the western river systems that make up the Lake Eyre Basin and some other interesting history.

A short refueling stop in Birdsville before we turn south flying over Goyder Lagoon, see the Simpson Desert and Lake Eyre North. Graham will be telling you some interesting facts as we look at this truly amazing expansive area.

Returning to Birdsville you will have an opportunity to visit the historic Birdsville Hotel and have a brief look around town.

Departing Birdsville, we will begin our return to Brisbane via Charleville.

8.00pm (Approximately) Arrive back at the General Aviation Terminal, Brisbane Airport.
